### Language

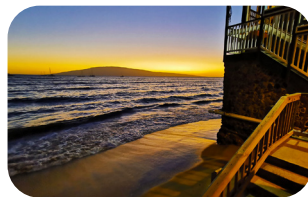
Hawaiian is an official language, but English is spoken most widely.
