Unlucky number

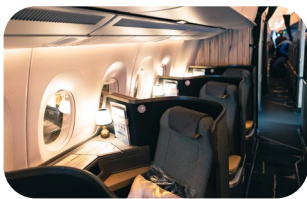
The number 4 in Japan is considered unlucky, so it's usually avoided.



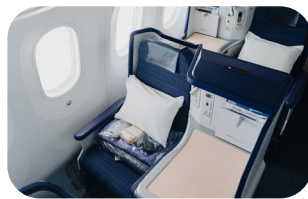
The scramble
